Selection of Professional Service Provider (PSP)

The Department of Water Affairs and Forestry (DWAF) seeks the services of a PSP to complete a study to clarify its institutional and organisational arrangements within which the anticipated PPP Toolkit for Tourism and procurement practice notes must be implemented, since National Treasury requires clear substantiation of institutional capacity before it will allow an institution to embark on such PPPs.

The contract for these services will be with a single service provider and all other team members must be hired via subcontract or joint venture. High quality expertise and experience is required relating to the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No.36 of 1998); institutionalisation of business processes; business process analysis; the Public Finance Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 1 of 1998); government procurement processes; National Treasury's Draft Tourism PPP Toolkit; tourism planning, development and economics; project management and administration; consultation and facilitation; quality report writing; and relevant word processing and computer programmes. Bids will be evaluated in terms of applicable procurement legislation, HDI ownership and participation, functionality and price considerations.
